### HEMET MODEL MASTERS BOARD MEETING

Minutes for June 11th, 2022

Meeting called to order by Secretary Steve Staudenmeir sitting in for Carl Lindou at 7:10PM. The meeting was held on-line.

Club Officers and Board Members Present — Steve Staudenmeir, Garrison Rios, Kevin McDonald, Tom Mulder, Lou Renteria, and Howard Hibbler.

There were no members or guests in attendance at the meeting.

The status of the lawsuit was discussed. The Board has been hoping that the lawsuit against the club would be dropped in exchange for membership and flying privileges but thus far there has been no change in status. At this point, the Board has concluded that resolving the lawsuit is beyond our control and a trial is likely to take place sometime in the near future.

The Board discussed the June Jet Rally. It was noted that the event was a success but attendance was down significantly from previous events and the event itself was not a money maker for the club as it has been in the past. 24 pilots participated (down from 60 in 2021). There were a number of reasons for the decline in attendance. High gas prices and high temperatures were major factors reported by various participants as well as feedback received. There have been suggestions that we change the timing of the event to encourage greater participation in the future.

As a result of attendance at the Jet Rally, we have a number of shirts leftover from the event. We decided to offer them to the membership at roughly cost at the next general membership meeting. The quality of these shirts is excellent and we are sure members will want one.

We also discussed the need for Officers and Board Members to attend general membership meetings whenever possible.

New Membership Director Jim Christy has made a major effort to get membership cards out to all members. Now that this has happened, we need to take a vote at the next membership meeting to require all members to have such cards in their possession whenever flying at club facilities.

There were no safety issues brought up at the meeting.

### HEMET MODEL MASTERS BOARD MEETING

Minutes for August 8th, 2022

Meeting called to order by President Carl Lindou at 7:12PM. The meeting was held on-line.

Club Officers and Board Members Present — Carl Lindou, Rodney Luker, Steve Staudenmeir, Garrison Rios, Kevin McDonald, Lou Renteria, Tom Mulder, Howard Hibbler and Jim Christy

There were no guests or members in attendance at the Board Meeting.

An initial draft of the bylaws compiled by Secretary Steve Staudenmeir was distributed to the officers and board members prior to the meeting via email. Steve led a discussion regarding some of the key provisions of the draft. The draft is a combination of the club's existing bylaws (in some cases revised) as well as those of the Orange County Modelers Association which had been suggested to us as a possible model. We had three primary goals in mind in drafting the new bylaws-

- To clarify existing provisions so that they could be consistently applied without leaving club policy unnecessarily subject to differing interpretations
- To clearly define unacceptable behavior at club facilities in order to maintain a safe and pleasant environment for all of our members to enjoy
- To minimize the potential for future lawsuits and financial harm to our club

The draft of the bylaws is currently under review. Once the Officers and Board Members have approved the draft it will be emailed out to the general membership for review and feedback prior to a vote on approval.

There is no change in status of the lawsuit. As stated previously, barring outside developments (e.g. the plaintiff dropping the suit) which are outside the control of our club, we anticipate that the lawsuit is headed to trial and we await further information and instructions from the club's attorney. Our attorney is obligated to represent the club regardless of our financial status.

We discussed the status of the field and runway maintenance at our main field. The Board voted to approve \$600 to have an outside party spray the tumbleweeds. Rodney Luker will discuss possible options for runway maintenance with the paving company.

Regarding safety, a concern was raised that certain members continue to violate club rules regarding not performing high speed passes over the runway. Safety Officer, Howard Hibbler agreed to address this directly with the member concerned.



No RV's or trailers are allowed West of the Handicap parking area. If you are parking a trailer in front of the shade structure, the total length must not exceed 18 feet or you must unhook.

### Safety At Club Flying Sites

Starting of any engines is north side of yellow line, aircraft facing runway. No taxing in the pits and staying within established perimeters, exceeding 400 ft ceiling. We have full scale aircraft overhead all the time and it only takes ONE incident to lose our field. No flying over the field workers on adjacent properties EVER!

All members are required to carry a first aid kit and fire extinguisher in their vehicles when flying. You never know when you or a fellow member will need some aid. Be prepared!! We strongly urge that no one fly alone.

TURBINE, IMAC and PATTERN MUST HAVE A SPOTTER WHEN FLYING!

### **Use of Club Facilities**

You must be a member of our club or a guest to use our facilities. Members please have your membership cards with you when you fly. Guests (per the bylaws) are allowed to fly three times prior to joining but must have an active AMA membership. Guests and 72mhz flyers must have AMA on frequency board prior to flying!

The Hemet Model Masters will extend courtesy membership to any "Active Military" individual allowing them to fly at our club fields as long as they have a current AMA membership.

### Retrieving Crashed Aircraft From the Aqueduct Near Our Main Field

Aqueduct Information for Retrieving crashed aircraft. Mike Thompson is the service representative that services the aqueduct near our main field. If your airplane is behind the second fence and not in the water runoff it is serviced by Mike Thompson. His direct line is 626 -844-5610. Note: Before calling be nice and explain that you are with the Hemet Model Masters and that you have crashed you're rc plane beyond the second fence and would like to retrieve it without breaking any laws. If your plane is between the first and second fence it is serviced by another agency (Securitas Security), Mike Thompson can not help you. Hopefully this will help our members to retrieve their aircraft.
