<u>HEMET MODEL MASTERS BOARD MEETING</u> Minutes for Aug 5, 2019

- Meeting called to order by President Richard Lawrence at 7:00 pm.
- Board members present; Stewart Robinson, Vincent Michael, Dwayne Higgenbothem, Jeff Barker, Eddie James, Kevin McDonald, and Steve Staudenmeir.
- Mario Muniz has agreed to remain on the board but not in the club secretary position.
- The Warbird event for August 9th and 10th was discussed and confirmed.
- Don Radford was voted in to replace the vacancy of Charles Lewis seat on the board, it was a unanimous vote.
- The subject of Charles Lewis was discussed. Charles has approached the District 10 VP (Laurence Tougas) regarding his separation from the club and has requested Mr. Tougas review the circumstances surrounding his dismissal. Charles feels he was dismissed without due process. Don Radford met with Charles Lewis at the Riverside flying site. Regarding the issue. HMM is expecting a letter from Charles regarding his position. Richard Lawrence reviewed the bylaws and it was determined article 13 was the area pertaining to the removal of Charles Lewis from the club. Club President Richard Lawrence is addressing his concerns.
- There was a verbal altercation at the field at some point over the past four weeks and a written warning was provided to the parties involved.
- Re-organization of the stand alone shade structures were discussed. The board reviewed a map of the field and discussed the proposed ideas. No final decision has been determined.
- Runway remodel was discussed. The cost of Richards PolyPavement is \$17,329 for material and \$17,000 for the contractor to perform the work. Total cost for the runway remodel would be \$34,329 and would include adding 25' to the east end of the runway, adding 45deg entrance and exit points from the pits to the runway, and removal of the broken up concrete off the far side of the runway. This would provide a "natural" color runway and we would need to "seal coat" the runway to have it black.
- There will be a special vote at the August General meeting regarding the remodel of the runway.
- IMAC would like to hold their qualifier in April of 2020. The Board has approved this.
- GATE CODES will be updated for both fields. The combination will be sent to each member



Aqueduct Information for Retrieving crashed aircraft. Mike Thompson is the service representative that services the aqueduct near our main field. If your airplane is behind the second fence and not in the water runoff it is serviced by Mike Thompson. His direct line is 626-844-5610. Note: Before calling be nice and explain that you are with the Hemet Model Masters and that you have crashed you're rc plane beyond the second fence and would like to retrieve it without breaking any laws. If your plane is between the first and second fence it is serviced by another agency (Securitas Security), Mike Thompson can not help you. Hopefully this will help our members to retrieve their aircraft.

Permanent TFRs issued for major sporting events and Disney properties

On October 27, 2018 the FAA issued three Permanent Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFRs) creating restrictions for the airspace surrounding major sporting events and the Disney properties in Anaheim CA and Orlando FL. The new flight

restrictions permanently prohibit the operation of unmanned and radio-controlled model aircraft within roughly 3.5 miles of both the Disneyland and Walt Disney World theme parks. The restrictions are also in place for a period of one hour before and one hour after major sporting events.
