The spot landing is pretty self-explanatory. The Roll, Roll, Roll. You Roll a pair of Dice get a number let say 9. Your time starts as soon as you start your take off. You do two rolls/ Or two Loops/ or two circles. You land your aircraft once below flying airspeed you can hand your transmitter to your spotter. Go back to the dice and Roll. Your Time stops once you've hit your original number which was a 9. The Dice evens the playing field. The events are designed to be very low risk to your aircraft and anyone can take part in no matter your skill level with any type of fixed wing aircraft. We will have a Raffle Food and drinks and Prizes. It is a 5\$ fee and a current AMA card no matter if you fly in the events or choose not to. Their will be open flying once the events have been completed and all the festivities have been completed. It was suggested that we try and do more fun things at the club meetings and field. This event is a way to have fun and enjoy the friendship of fellow modelers. I hope you all can come participate in the Fun Fly. Okay Rules at the field. First off, I didn't personally make them. They were written from the AMA Safety guidelines. The guidelines every club MUST follow to retain its Club charter and keep its AMA insurance coverage on the field. And rules were developed over the years by the Members and Board of Directors. Based on either foreseen safety issues. Or accidents that have occurred most likely several times. Here's A basic rule at the field that is repeatedly broken. YOU DO NOT. TAXI FROM THE PITS TO THE RUNWAY. AND YOU DO NOT TAXI FROM THE RUNWAY INTO THE PITS. And it doesn't matter what type of aircraft you have. I personally have seen several collisions of all different types of aircraft and powerplants. These are accidents that shouldn't have ever happened. Look I do not like going on and on about rules. The Rules are posted at the field they are very simple to follow. Because I personally would rather talk to you about your airplane and enjoy your company. Then tell you that when you joined the Hemet Model Masters you agreed to follow the rules so please do so.

The members discussed what could be done to improve participation in future swap meets based upon lessons learned from the January swap meet event. Carl Landou handed out some safety guidelines which were generally accepted as reasonable by the members present. There was some discussion about whether 3D flyers needed a spotter and the member's present voted that one should not be required provided the 400 foot altitude restriction was adhered to. All flights over 400 feet regardless of the type of plane require a spotter.

A club fun fly is scheduled for February 12th (subsequently rescheduled to February 19th). There will be a \$5 event fee (basically to help cover lunch). There will be two competitive events (Spot Landing and Roll, Roll, Roll) and should be fun for everyone participating. All types of fixed wing aircraft are welcome to participate.

Everyone was reminded that we have the Harry Gould Memorial Pattern Competition scheduled for March 18th to 20th, an IMAC Competition in April and a Jet Rally in June. Additional information will be forthcoming.



No RV's or trailers are allowed West of the Handicap parking area. If you are parking a trailer in front of the shade structure, the total length must not exceed 18 feet or you must unhook.

Safety At Club Flying Sites

Starting of any engines is north side of yellow line, aircraft facing runway. No taxing in the pits and staying within established perimeters, exceeding 400 ft ceiling. We have full scale aircraft overhead all the time and it only takes ONE incident to lose our field. No flying over the field workers on adjacent properties EVER!

All members are required to carry a first aid kit and fire extinguisher in their vehicles when flying. You never know when you or a fellow member will need some aid. Be prepared!! We strongly urge that no one fly alone.

TURBINE, IMAC and PATTERN MUST HAVE A SPOTTER WHEN FLYING!

Use of Club Facilities

You must be a member of our club or a guest to use our facilities. Members please have your membership cards with you when you fly. Guests (per the bylaws) are allowed to fly three times prior to joining but must have an active AMA membership. Guests and 72mhz flyers must have AMA on frequency board prior to flying!

The Hemet Model Masters will extend courtesy membership to any "Active Military" individual allowing them to fly at our club fields as long as they have a current AMA membership.

Retrieving Crashed Aircraft From the Aqueduct Near Our Main Field

Aqueduct Information for Retrieving crashed aircraft. Mike Thompson is the service representative that services the aqueduct near our main field. If your airplane is behind the second fence and not in the water runoff it is serviced by Mike Thompson. His direct line is 626 -844-5610. Note: Before calling be nice and explain that you are with the Hemet Model Masters and that you have crashed you're rc plane beyond the second fence and would like to retrieve it without breaking any laws. If your plane is between the first and second fence it is serviced by another agency (Securitas Security), Mike Thompson can not help you. Hopefully this will help our members to retrieve their aircraft.
