- Meeting called to order by President Stewart Robinson at 7:02 pm.
- Board members present; Richard Lawrence, Kevin McDonald, Vincent Michael, Mario Muniz, Eddie James, Don Turner, Don Radford and Steve Staudenmeir.
- Guest members present: Scott Boersma and Lawrence Vasquez
- A drawing was conducted to determine the annual winner of the prize for show and tell. Member Scott Boersma drew the winning ticket and the winner was Kevin McDonald who received \$200. A decision was made to reduce future show and tell prizes to \$100.
- A discussion was held regarding the club's response to a recent lawsuit. On January 1, 2020 an email was sent to all members requesting a vote to retain a lawyer to represent the club. During the Board Meeting, Secretary Steve Staudenmeir reported that 31 members had responded to the email and the results were as follows:
 - 26 members voted yes to authorize retaining the attorney
 - 4 members voted no
 - 1 member abstained from voting

In accordance with the vote, the club has retained an attorney for \$5,000 to represent the club through the initial stages of the lawsuit.

• Board Member Richard Lawrence made a motion that the President will investigate and secure appropriate liability insurance to protect the club and board members against future lawsuits. Board Member Don Radford seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously approved.

HOSTED BY HEMET MODEL MASTERS MARCH 14-15, 2019

Sportsman, Intermediate, Advanced, Masters, FAI (P-18, F-18), and FAI Silver if there is enough interest will be flown. Awards to 3rd place in each class. This is an AMA sanctioned event so proof of AMA membership must be provided when registering. Sportsman Class will be allowed to fly any AMA legal airplane. \$40 for all classes except Sportsman which is \$30. Lunch will be available at the field for a nominal fee. Water is complementary. Camping is allowed at the field – no hook-ups.

Field is open at 8:am, with pilots meeting at 8:45 – wheels up at 9:00. Sun is an issue here in the afternoon, so we must get things started early. 2 flight lines will be used with contestant judging. 

PLEASE ADHERE TO CLUB SAFETY POLICIES, THESE WERE PUT IN PLACE BY YOU THE MEMBERS AND A FEW OF YOU CONTINUE TO IGNORE THEM.

Starting of any engines is north side of yellow line, aircraft facing runway. No taxing in the pits and staying within established perimeters, exceeding 400 ft ceiling. We have full scale aircraft overhead all the time and it only takes ONE incident to lose our field. No flying over the field workers on adjacent properties EVER!

Aqueduct Information for Retrieving crashed aircraft. Mike Thompson is the service representative that services the aqueduct near our main field. If your airplane is behind the second fence and not in the water runoff it is serviced by Mike Thompson. His direct line is 626-844-5610. Note: Before calling be nice and explain that you are with the Hemet Model Masters and that you have crashed you're rc plane beyond the second fence and would like to retrieve it without breaking any laws. If your plane is between the first and second fence it is serviced by another agency (Securitas Security), Mike Thompson can not help you. Hopefully this will help our members to retrieve their aircraft.

Permanent TFRs issued for major sporting events and Disney properties

On October 27, 2018 the FAA issued three Permanent Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFRs) creating restrictions for the airspace surrounding major sporting events and the Disney properties in Anaheim CA and Orlando FL. The new flight

restrictions permanently prohibit the operation of unmanned and radio-controlled model aircraft within roughly 3.5 miles of both the Disneyland and Walt Disney World theme parks. The restrictions are also in place for a period of one hour before and one hour after major sporting events.
