HEMET MODEL MASTERS BOARD MEETING

Minutes for July 2, 2018

Meeting called to order by President Richard Lawrence at 7:00 pm. Board members present; Mario Muniz, Stewart Robinson, Dwayne Higgenbotham, Jeff Barker, Ralph Torres, Vincent Michael and Steve Staudenmeir.

Meeting began with President Richard Lawrence talking about the proposed extension to the runway. Adding 25 feet to each end and then doing the repairs and overlay of the runway.

Secretary Mario Muniz mentioned that new member Neal Smiley will do what he can to approach his contacts to put on a jet event with 20 to 25 pilots at HMM. He will try to see if he can gather support from vendors in the RC Industry. The traditional raffle would be replaced by an auction with proceeds going to the club's runway fund. This could be a yearly event and adding to the length of the runway would attract more pilots to the events at HMM and as a result perhaps garner more members who would enjoy the improvements to the facility.

Secretary Mario Muniz also said he would approach HSD to see if their pilots would be interested in attending the event and perhaps donating prizes for the event. President Richard Lawrence mentioned that these proceeds will be designated for the runway at HMM and not for any other use.

President Richard Lawrence is hoping that some of the members might be willing to donate money towards the runway fund. Ralph Torres mentioned that we need to get a NOTAM if we have a jet event. Of course we are aware that if we put on an event of this caliber a NOTAM will be required.

President Richard Lawrence called for new business, the chair recognizes Steve Staudenmeir. Steve spoke about the cancelation of the General Meeting last month. VP Floyd Whitehorn stated that only a few people were there and he had no information for the meeting. Steve mentioned that it has happened recently and President Richard Lawrence mentioned that one of the meetings was cancelled because of rain. Steve stated that he was embarrassed because he had no information about the meeting. He stated that we need to do a better job of advising everyone about any cancellations that may occur. President Richard Lawrence made some comments about some of the meetings with very low attendance and will try to make some type of adjustments.

Treasurer Stewart Robinson made some comments about the subject and agrees with some of the points made by Steve, but he was unable to be there and feels that Steve is pushing the subject a little too much and reminded him that we are accountable but we are doing this as volunteers and sometimes things can happen as regrettable as it may be. Time was spent seeking information on what constitutes a quorum for the sake of future meetings and a decision will be forthcoming on this subject.

The rest of the meeting consisted of discussing how many members need to be present for a General Meeting and the subject was dropped as related to how many people have to be there. Board meetings are a different subject and a majority of the board members must be present to conduct a board meeting.

Safety Officer Vincent Michael stated that sometimes things happen that are unexpected and the members must understand that.

Vincent Michael brought up the By-Laws and how we plan to address the changes that need to happen in order to bring the document into a more complete form for the club and its members. President Richard Lawrence will address the changes that need to occur in a future meeting.

President Richard wants the club field rules placed on the website. We will be looking at the rules and getting them posted to the site very soon.

NOTICE TO ALL HMM MEMBERS

We have been contacted by the County of Riverside in regards to the Menifee Valley RC Flyers and their flying site. The County will be doing construction at there field beginning in October and lasting approximately 55 days, during which time they have made a request, if we could allow the Menifee club to use our facilities at the Lakewood/Davis flying field which is also County owned but under lease to the Hemet Model Masters until construction is completed.

The Board of Directors of the Hemet Model Masters has granted the County's request and has gone on to allow the Menifee Valley RC Flyers access to both our flying sites during that time period.

We have notified them that they must wear their club membership identification while flying at HMM and they must abide by HMM club rules. Ex; spotter required when flying Pattern, Imac sequences and Turbine pilots must have a spotter to fly at HMM at all times.

A note to all members; the AMA show to be held in November at the Pomona Fairplex is probably going to be huge. Bldg 4 where the show will be indoors is almost completely sold out. Noteworthy mention is that HobbyKing plans to be there for the first time ever in California.

Anyone wanting advance tickets to the show at group rates see Mario Muniz.

As you can see on page 6 of the newsletter the prices are going up. Good news is the group ticket price only went up a dollar, but now it says plus fees??

HMM Club Rules for the flying sites are being worked on by President Richard Lawrence and Secretary Mario Muniz. Some of the field rules are outdated or missing subject matter that should be included in the club rules. These items need to be brought current to cover conditions that have changed over the past few years. When they are finished they will be presented to the Board of Directors and to the Membership for final approval.

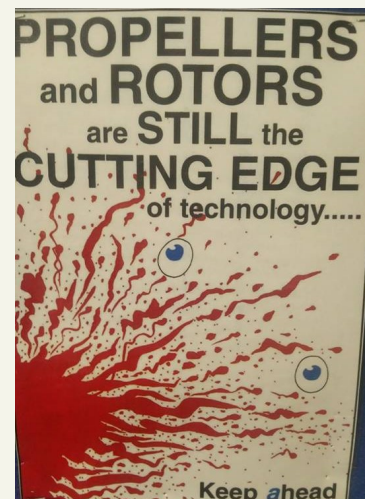
We will then have new signage made and posted at both flying sites.

Aqueduct Information for Retrieving crashed aircraft. Mike Thompson is the service representative that services the aqueduct near our main field. If your airplane is behind the second fence and not in the water runoff it is serviced by Mike Thompson. His direct line is 626-844-5610. Note: Before calling be nice and explain that you are with the Hemet Model Masters and that you have crashed you're rc plane beyond the second fence and would like to retrieve it without breaking any laws. If your plane is between the first and second fence it is serviced by another agency (Securitas Security), Mike Thompson can not help you. Hopefully this will help our members to retrieve their aircraft.

FAA Guidelines

- All aircraft that are flown using a ground control system, such as a transmitter, are required to participate. This includes fixed-wing aircraft, not just multi-rotors or drones. • Any pilot flying models weighing between .55 pounds (or 250 grams) and 55 lbs is required to register. You only need to register once every 3 years.

Permanent TFRs issued for major sporting events and Disney properties

On October 27, the FAA issued three Permanent Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFRs) creating restrictions for the airspace surrounding major sporting events and the Disney properties in Anaheim CA and Orlando FL. The new flight restrictions permanently prohibit the operation of unmanned and radio-controlled model aircraft within roughly 3.5 miles of both the Disneyland and Walt Disney World theme parks. The restrictions are also in place for a period of one hour before and one hour after major sporting events.

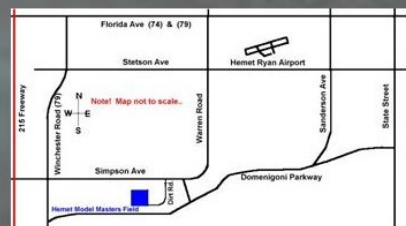

We have full scale aircraft overhead all the time and it only takes ONE incident to lose our field. No flying over the field workers on adjacent properties EVER!
