- The runway repaying is set for October 28th or possibly earlier if the contractor's schedule permits. The project is scheduled to take one day.
- A safety concern was raised that we need to remind all of our members not to fly over farm workers in the fields adjacent to ours. Please wait until workers have moved safely away from the areas we fly over.
- Charles Lewis is still petitioning the Board to reinstate his membership.
- Nominations and balloting for officers and board members will be coming up soon and an appropriate process needs to be put in place to ensure that this occurs smoothly.
- Stewart presented examples of the new membership cards that will be distributed this year. The cards are plastic and permanent and will only require a renewal sticker to be affixed to each card rather than printing new cards each year.

HEMET MODEL MASTERS GENERAL MEETING Minutes for "September 21, 2019"

Meeting called to order by Richard Lawrence

- Pledge of allegiance
- Meeting minutes Motion to accept by Kevin McDonald and seconded by Steve Staudenmeir, all approved.
- Treasurers report: was reported by Treasurer Stewart Robinson. Motion to accept by Kevin McDonald, Seconded by Eddie James, all approved.
- The club welcomed one guest, Joey Cass.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Richard Lawrence presented a contractor bid for \$38,000 that will include a mesh overlay of the entire runway topped by 1 1/2 inches of asphalt paving. This was the type of improvement the club has been seeking for some time and was a one-time offer by the contractor given that such work would typically be quite a bit more costly. A vote was taken of the members in attendance and the bid was overwhelming approved. Of the 24 members in attendance, 22 voted to approve the project with 2 voting against. The repaving projected is expected to be completed by the end of October.
- Member Steve Beswick has done some valuable research regarding various approaches to the runway project and he passed out some quotes he had received. However, the approach that Richard Lawrence presented was consistent with what the club has been seeking and as a result further discussion of Steve's approaches was tabled.

• NEW BUSINESS:

- There was some discussion whether County of Riverside discretionary funding might be available to assist with the funding of the runway repaying project. Stewart Robinson agreed to contact the County regarding this possibility.
- Given the amount of club funds that will be spent repaying the runway the club voted that raffles will be suspended until the Toys for Tots event in December.

Metropolitan Water District

Aqueduct Information for Retrieving crashed aircraft. Mike Thompson is the service representative that services the aqueduct near our main field. If your airplane is behind the second fence and not in the water runoff it is serviced by Mike Thompson. His direct line is 626-844-5610. Note: Before calling be nice and explain that you are with the Hemet Model Masters and that you have crashed you're rc plane beyond the second fence and would like to retrieve it without breaking any laws. If your plane is between the first and second fence it is serviced by another agency (Securitas Security), Mike Thompson can not help you. Hopefully this will help our members to retrieve their aircraft.

Permanent TFRs issued for major sporting events and Disney properties

On October 27, 2018 the FAA issued three Permanent Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFRs) creating restrictions for the airspace surrounding major sporting events and the Disney properties in Anaheim CA and Orlando FL. The new flight

restrictions permanently prohibit the operation of unmanned and radio-controlled model aircraft within roughly 3.5 miles of both the Disneyland and Walt Disney World theme parks. The restrictions are also in place for a period of one hour before and one hour after major sporting events.

PLEASE ADHERE TO CLUB SAFETY POLICIES, THESE WERE PUT IN PLACE BY YOU THE MEMBERS AND A FEW OF YOU CONTINUE TO IGNORE THEM.

Starting of any engines is north side of yellow line, aircraft facing runway. No taxing in the pits and staying within established perimeters, exceeding 400 ft ceiling. We have full scale aircraft overhead all the time and it only takes ONE incident to lose our field. No flying over the field workers on adjacent properties EVER!
