Hello fellow club members,

We have a tentative settlement agreement on the table which has been approved by both parties and we are awaiting final completion of the related paperwork. In addition, revised Bylaws have been drafted and approved by the Board and are currently undergoing review by the Club's attorney.

Unfortunately, the Settlement will not make a number of people happy. But to further pursue litigation would have involved significantly more legal and court costs than has already been expended with no guarantees of a favorable judgement and no recovery of legal costs. Regard-less of outcome, there would be no "win" for the club. At this point, we can move forward and not feel like we are digging a deeper hole.

Moving forward it is important to remember that members must behave civilly to one another. No one has the right to harass, degrade or threaten anyone at the field. It's going to be part of the new Bylaws. If you have a problem with someone, ignore them or GO HOME. I've made reference to the first R/C Club I joined when I moved to the inland empire 100 yeas ago. We all had such a great time together. And I honestly see glimpses of that camaraderie with the Hemet Model Masters. And I'd like to build upon that. We have much that needs to be done. And by working together we can build club camaraderie and improve the flying field.

Minutes for August 20th, 2022

Meeting called to order by President Carl Landou at 9:10 AM

12 members and 1 guest were in attendance. The guest was Michael Paurazas.

A motion was made by Lou Renteria to approve last months minutes as published in the newsletter and seconded by Chad Phillips. The motion was approved.

The Treasurer's report was not read because the Treasurer was unable to attend the meeting.

There has not a lot happening this month due to the summer heat. Also, the Scale Flyers event previously scheduled for September has been postponed due to the heat. No information regarding the rescheduled event is available at this time.

The field was scheduled to be sprayed (herbicide) but was postponed because the spraying equipment broke down. We anticipate that the field will be sprayed in the next week or so.

The club continues to try to settle the outstanding lawsuit. No agreement has been achieved to date.

Steve Staudenmeir reported that the club has drafted a new Bylaws which is currently being reviewed by the club officers and board members. Once it has been approved by the Board, we will circulate it to the general membership for review and approval.

The members present indicated that they would be interested in purchasing club T-shirts were we to have some made. Carl indicated he would look into this.

We plan to have a Fun Fly during the month of October. Cory and Dylan Robinson indicated an interest in combat flying. We asked them if they could do a combat demo at our upcoming September meeting so other members could see what it was all about.

We plan to schedule a clean up day the second week of October so members can earn volunteer credits.

Other things that need to be scheduled are the Fall Swap Meet and an introductory flight training day.

HEMET MODEL MASTERS BOARD MEETING

Minutes for September 5th, 2022

Meeting called to order by President Carl Lindou at 7:03PM. The meeting was held on-line.

David Grabhorn, Esq., our club attorney attended as a guest

The bulk of the meeting was devoted to the proposed settlement of the lawsuit. Attorney Grabhorn summarized the proposed settlement and answered questions. He recommended that the Board agree to the settlement as the only alternative would be to proceed to trial and the large amount of cost that would entail with no guaranteed outcome. The Board thanked Mr. Grabhorn for his work and he was excused from the meeting. A vote was then taken as to whether to approve the settlement. The vote was unanimous to approve the settlement by those present including Rodney Luker who was not present but had communicated to Carl Lindou his vote prior to the meeting. The final settlement is pending completion of paperwork as of this time but should be done shortly. The terms of the settlement are not to be disclosed outside the Officers and Board except on a strict need to know basis as per the settlement agreement.

The Board voted to spend up to \$1,000 in additional legal fees for our attorney to review our proposed Bylaws.

Pending the results of the review of the proposed Bylaws by the attorney, a vote was taken to approve the Proposed Bylaws. The Proposed Bylaws were unanimously approved. The next step in the approval process will be to forward the Proposed Bylaws to the General Membership for review and approval which will take place shortly after we have received feedback from the club's attorney. We hope to get them out to the general membership shortly.



Parking Plan For the Main Field

Parking by the shade structure is reserved for pilots. Non-flying individuals, spectators and guests are to park south of the shade structure. No RV's or trailers are allowed West of the Handicap parking area. If you are parking a trailer in front of the shade structure, the total length must not exceed 18 feet or you must unhook.

Safety At Club Flying Sites

Starting of any engines is north side of yellow line, aircraft facing runway. No taxing in the pits and staying within established perimeters, exceeding 400 ft ceiling. We have full scale aircraft overhead all the time and it only takes ONE incident to lose our field. No flying over the field workers on adjacent properties EVER!

All members are required to carry a first aid kit and fire extinguisher in their vehicles when flying. You never know when you or a fellow member will need some aid. Be prepared!! We strongly urge that no one fly alone.

TURBINE, IMAC and PATTERN MUST HAVE A SPOTTER WHEN FLYING!

Use of Club Facilities

You must be a member of our club or a guest to use our facilities. Members please have your membership cards with you when you fly. Guests (per the bylaws) are allowed to fly three times prior to joining but must have an active AMA membership. Guests and 72mhz flyers must have AMA on frequency board prior to flying!

The Hemet Model Masters will extend courtesy membership to any "Active Military" individual allowing them to fly at our club fields as long as they have a current AMA membership.

Retrieving Crashed Aircraft From the Aqueduct Near Our Main Field

Aqueduct Information for Retrieving crashed aircraft. Mike Thompson is the service representative that services the aqueduct near our main field. If your airplane is behind the second fence and not in the water runoff it is serviced by Mike Thompson. His direct line is 626 -844-5610. Note: Before calling be nice and explain that you are with the Hemet Model Masters and that you have crashed you're rc plane beyond the second fence and would like to retrieve it without breaking any laws. If your plane is between the first and second fence it is serviced by another agency (Securitas Security), Mike Thompson can not help you. Hopefully this will help our members to retrieve their aircraft.
